15 Hours of Funded Childcare, childcarechoices.gov.uk:

Some 3 & 4 year olds are eligible for 30 hours Free Childcare a week. However, *US Forces are typically only eligible for 15 hours*. The authorization form may ask for a National Insurance Number (NIN). A NIN is used verify eligibility for an add'l 15 hours. If a NIN can be provided, a UK passport and UK pay report may also be requested to determine eligibility for add'l 15 hours per wk.
